

THIS GENERAL AGREEMENT OF COLLABORATION AND ACADEMIC INTERCHANGE IS MADE AND ENTERED INTO BY AND BETWEEN THE **WORLD RESSOURCES INSTITUTE**, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS "THE WRI" REPRESENTED BY THE WRI SECRETARY-TREASURER, MARJORIE BEANE, AND THE **UNIVERSITY OF GUADALAJARA**, IN MEXICO, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS "THE UNIVERSITY", REPRESENTED BY ITS RECTOR, RAUL PADILLA LOPEZ, AND THE SECRETARY GENERAL, GUILLERMO A. GOMEZ REYES. THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING CLAUSES:

WITNESSETH

1. "THE WRI" DECLARES:

1.1 Whereas **"The WRI"** is a policy research institute which assists governments, the private sector, organizations dedicated to the environment and development, and other institutions, having as its objective a fundamental question: How can societies satisfy human needs and obtain economic growth, without destroying the natural reSSources and environmental wholeness that make prosperity possible? "The WRI", through its studies of politics, seeks the generation of precise information concerning world reSSources and environmental conditions, analyzes the problems which arise and develops creative but applicable policy responses.

1.2 Whereas **"THE WRI"** is an independent non-profit association, which receives financial support from foundations and private corporations, government and intergovernmental institutions, and interested parties.

1.3 Whereas it will be represented by its Secretary-Treasurer Marjorie Beane, in this agreement.

1.4 Whereas its legal address is: 1709 New York Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20006, U.S.A.

2. "THE UNIVERSITY" DECLARES:

2.1 Whereas, it is a higher educational institution recognized officially by the Mexican Government, having been created by Decree number 2721 of the Congress of the State of Jalisco on september 7, 1925, which made possible the issuance of the first Bylaws of the University of Guadalajara on the 25th of that same month and year;

2.2 Whereas, it is a decentralized agency of the State Government, with its own autonomy, legal status, and proprietorship, in accord with the provisions of Article 1 of its Bylaws, promulgated by the local Executive branch on January 15, 1994, in fulfillment of decree number 15319 of the Congress of the State of Jalisco.

- 2.3 Whereas, according to clauses I, II, III, and IV of Article 5 of the University's Bylaws, now in effect, the aims of this University are: to provide training and continuing education for technicians, undergraduates, technical professionals, graduate students and whatever human resources are necessary for socio-economic development of the State; to organize, conduct, promote and spread research in liberal arts, science, and technology; to protect, preserve, develop and spread culture; and to cooperate with the proper educational authorities in the orientation and promotion of high school and higher education, as well as in the development of science and technology.
- 2.4 Whereas, the mission of the University of Guadalajara, in accord with Article 6, clause III, is to carry out teaching, research and cultural diffusion programs, consonant with the principles and orientations prescribed in Article 3 of the Federal Constitution;
- 2.5 Whereas, the Rector General is the highest executive authority of the University, its legal representative President of the General Council of the University and of the Rectors' Council, in accord with the stipulations of Article 32 of the Bylaws of the University of Guadalajara.
- 2.6 Whereas, the Rector General in accord with Article 35, clause X of the Bylaws, is empowered to promote everything that contributes to the academic and administrative improvement of the University and its infrastructure and endowment; and
- 2.7 Whereas, its legal address is the building located at Avenida Juarez #975, C.P. 44100 S.J. Guadalajara, Jalisco. However, departments may be established, educational services provided, and institutional functions may be carried out in various regions of Jalisco in accord with Article 4 of the above-mentioned Bylaws.

BOTH PARTIES DECLARE:

Both subscribers--in serving their respective objectives, aims and functions--consider it of vital importance to promote and support education, diffusion and the extension of the limits of knowledge concerning natural resources and conservation of the environment.

CLAUSES


FIRST The objective of the present agreement is the publication by "The University" of "Guía de Educación Ambiental sobre Temas del Desarrollo Sostenible," previously published by "The WRI" as "The Teacher's Guide to World Resources" and adapted for Latin America by Margot Aguilar of the Environmental Studies Group

under an agreement with "The WRI".


- SECOND "The University" will be in agreement to revise the manuscript and to provide useful bibliographic references for teachers related to the topics of each chapter.
- THIRD "The University" will finance an edition of 3,000 copies, to be distributed as follows: 1,000 copies will be delivered to the Environmental Studies Group (GEA), another 1,000 copies to "The WRI", and the remaining 1,000 copies will be for "The University". 100 of the 1,000 copies for GEA will be remitted to GEA in September. The copies for "The WRI" will be remitted by UPS International, with charges paid by "The University", to: The World Resources Institute C/O MAILBAG, 201 Commerce Dr., Upper Marlboro, MD 20772 U.S.A.
- FOURTH "The WRI" conveys all publishing rights in Latin America, with the exception of Columbia, for the first edition of the Guide to "The University", with the understanding that permission for reprinting will be conveyed without charge to educational groups in other Spanish-speaking countries that wish to use the Guide as a base for creating a similar Guide adapted to their own countries, giving credit to "The WRI", GEA, and "The University." "The University" will inform "The WRI" of the appropriate names and addresses of any permission for reprinting the Guide, whether in whole or in part. The favorable transference of subsidies from electronic films, audio-visuals or others will be covered in a separate agreement.
- FIFTH "The University" will include the Guide in its annual catalogue of publications for at least two years, and will launch the Guide's publication during the annual Book Fair in November, 1994, along with a teacher's training workshop, for with "The WRI" will send a representative.


Both parties fully accept the stipulations of this agreement as well as its execution. It will become effective as soon as both parties sign this document.


